
# **DL-101 Installation Manual**

The DuraLock DL-100 series is designed to lock trailer doors offering excellent protection against theft. It is bolted to the door without drilling new holes. Simply undo the 2 nuts holding the door hasp and install the DuraLock using the same holes. When engaged, the DuraLock strong pin secures the handle in place.

It unlocks with a key. Designed to meet extreme weather conditions.

## **Packaging Content:**

- 1. 1x DuraLock
- 2. 3x Keys
- 3. 2x screws 3/8"-24 x 1 1/4" \*
- 4. 2x screws 3/8"-24 x 3 1/2" \*
- 5 Installation Manual



### **Tools Needed:**

- 1. Allen Wrench 7/32"
- Nut wrench 9/16" or 15mm or adjustable wrench



#### Notes:

- The 1 ½" long screws supplied with the DuraLock are suitable for the standard ½" thick trailer doors.
- Doors that are thicker than ½", require mounting screws that are equal to the thickness of the door plus ½".
- 2x 3½" screws provided for 3" thick doors such as reefer.
- The screws are 3/8" 24 x L" (L = the required length).



# **DL-101 Installation Manual**



### Remove the HASP from the trailer door


 Undo the 2 screws and nuts holding the HASP to the Door

### Adjust the spacing of the floating socket to match the holes on the door.

- Measure the hole spacing on the trailer door
- Adjust the floating socket on the DuraLock to match the spacing on the door





#### Install the DuraLock

- Insert the two 3/8"-24 x 1 ¼" screws into the holes of the door
- Line up the bottom screw on the door with the bottom hole of the DuraLock and turn the screw until it is engaged. Do not tighten the screw.
- Line up the top screw of the door with the top hole of the DuraLock and turn the screw until it is engaged
- · Tighten both screws
